



UNIFORM POLICY

A school uniform gives children a sense of belonging, fosters identity and pride in the school, provides safety and discourages fashion competition. All children are required to wear the recommended school uniform unless exempted or in exceptional circumstances. In this case, a note to the class teacher or message to the office is required.

Coorara Primary School's uniform is endorsed by Governing Council and is smart, practical and based on the school colours of red and black. Our school uniform consists of:

SCHOOL LOGO POLO SHIRTS

- Black with red trim short sleeved polo shirt with the school logo on the front. Plain black skivvies / long sleeves can be worn under the shirt in cooler weather.

JACKETS

- Plain red windcheater, jumper or jacket with logo
- Plain black windcheater, jumper or jacket with logo

PANTS

- Must be plain black and may include track pants, shorts or cotton pants. For practicality and modesty, shorts and skirts must be midlength.

DRESSES AND SKIRTS

- Black plain skirts.
- Red / white checked uniform dress.

HATS, HEADWEAR & HAIR COLOUR

In accordance with our sun smart policy, it is expected that all students wear a school bucket hat while in the yard. Baseball hats are not sun safe. In term 1 and 4, no hat means no play in the sun. In the interests of student safety and to prevent the spread of head lice, we encourage hair to be tied back from the face in a style which allows a hat to be worn. Natural coloured hair is preferred. Hair accessories must fit flat against the head

FOOTWEAR

Shoes for school are sandshoes/sneakers or black shoes and must be suitable for PE and other sporting activities. For safety reasons, all footwear must have an enclosed toe. If footwear is deemed unsafe or impractical, parents/carers will be contacted.



UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING STYLES OR ACCESSORIES

Are those deemed by the school to be offensive or inappropriate in terms of safety, suitability for school activities and exposure to the weather and include:

- Jeans/denim
- Clothing with commercial brand logos larger than a hand palm size (front or back)
- Tank tops or shoestring shoulder straps
- Ugg boots, thongs, fashion sandals, slip on or backless shoes, steel capped boots or gum boots.
- Nail polish and make up (students will be asked to remove or wash off make up at school)
- Unnatural, bright, or flamboyant artificially coloured hair is discouraged.
- Facial piercings
- Fashion jewellery and accessories
- Transfers or temporary tattoos
- Representative jumpers for SAPSASA/school representation/school sporting or other teams may be worn the day after the event only. In acknowledgement of the event and representation of the school, the jumper must be the property of the participant.

Any families experiencing difficulty in adhering to this policy, are advised to contact the front office for support.
