## Message from the Principal – Steph Tulloch

What a full schedule we have coming up. Transition visits are happening soon – to Wirreanda High School, and for our new reception children starting in Term 3. We have an excursion in week 7, and performances coming in to school to both educate and entertain our students.

Today's newsletter is full of reminders – please have a good read.

**Seesaw** is our means of classroom communication – can you ensure you are linked on for sharing of events, classroom photos, relevant information etc. We are not going to use the FROG portal due to issues in the system. We apologise for the delay in this. We did not release how difficult it would be. If you are having difficulty linking on, please see your child's teacher.

**Excursion to Hallett Cove and Ityamaitpinna Yarta, (Glenthorne National Park):** We are all excited for our excursion on next Thursday, 29 May to Hallett Cove and Ityamaitpinna Yarta. Please make sure your children arrive at school on time as the buses depart at 9am, and have in their bag their lunch (if required), drink bottle, and recess. If you have ordered a Subway lunch for your child, it will be delivered to them at Glenthorne. There is minimal shade at the park so a hat is optional should you wish your child to wear one. They must be in school uniform and be wearing good walking shoes. If your child is not attending, please ensure you have called in their absence by 9am. Thank you to the Variety Club for their assistance with the bus costs, keeping your contribution as low as possible.

**Healthy Food:** We have noticed an increase in less healthy foods in some children's lunchboxes. Around 10am each day we have 'Crunch and Sip', our fruit/vegetable and water break in all classes. Please can you try to ensure your child has something suitable to eat at this time. Lollies/candy and well as fizzy/energy drinks are not to be brought to school. We are following the DfE Right Bite Policy. Thank you for your support in this area.

**Highschool registration:** All Year 6 parents will have received information about high school enrolments. Most families have completed the forms; however, we still have some outstanding – Please ensure you check your email and submit your choices. If you need any help, please contact Sandy in the front office.

**Uniform:** Please ensure your child is attending school in the correct school uniform. This means black mid-thigh shorts, black leggings and pants, correct school jackets and tops with our logo, and closed toed shoes/sneakers. If you require a uniform, please see the uniform shop opening times are : Monday & Friday 8:30am – 9:00am, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday 3:00pm – 3:20pm. Uniform notes will be coming out to you if your child is not following the uniform code.

Finally, we will have a photographer in school on Tuesday 27 May. He is updating our school photos for our front admin wall, publications, website and information booklets, as well as walls around the school. We will be taking photos of students in our new school uniform and logo. If you do not wish for your child to have their photo taken, please advise the school office.
