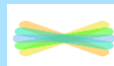
Dear Families,

All students have a **communication book** or **diary**. You and your child's teacher can communicate via handwritten notes.



Our school has a **Facebook Page**. Follow us to keep informed of upcoming events, important dates, highlights of our teaching and learning program and read our latest newsletter.

Contact school staff via telephone. Our school office is open 8:00am - 4:00pm daily during the school term.



Face to face meetings are often best if you have a concern about your child's progress or wish to share some important information. To arrange this, please make a time directly with your child's teacher.

Informal chats before or after school: classrooms open at 8:40 am and teachers are available for ten minutes before the bell goes for a quick chat. Most days Donna and I are in the yard before or after school please feel free to chat with us at this time. Teachers are not available on Wednesday

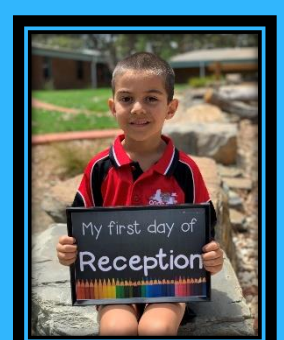

IGNITE at Aberfoyle Park High School

IGNITE is a specialist program for students with high intellectual potential. Aberfoyle Park High School is the official Department for Education school for gifted students in the southern metropolitan area of Adelaide.

HOW DO I KNOW IF MY CHILD IS GIFTED?

The characteristics of gifted children vary; however, many display some or all of the following traits:

- High levels of curiosity and deep levels of knowledge in one or more area
- Excellent creative thinking and ability to problem solve
- Strong empathy and social justice
- Highly developed sense of humour



Initial selection is based on performance in the Australian Council for Education (ACER) Gifted and Talented Assessment.

Year 6 students are eligible to sit the test for a place in the Year 7 IGNITE program in 2022.
Year 7 students are eligible to sit the test for a place in the Year 8 IGNITE program in 2022.
