Staying connected to your child's learning and the school has never been easier..... there are many ways to communicate with our staff and to stay informed.

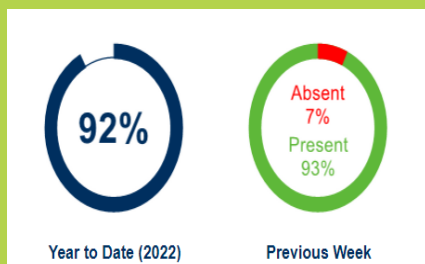

Breakfast Club

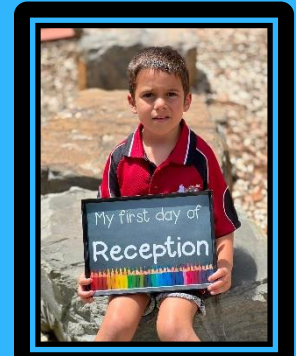

Skoolbag App that allows you to keep track of important dates, read the latest newsletter and notes.



See Saw App is accessible via phone, tablet or computer. Works as a communication tool, class blog and student portfolio of learning.



You and staff can communicate with each other via **email**. You can also receive newsletters via email.



All students have a **communication book** or **diary**. You and your child's teacher can communicate via handwritten notes.



Our school has a **Facebook Page**. Follow us to keep informed of upcoming events, important dates, highlights of our teaching and learning program and read our latest newsletter.

Contact school staff via telephone. Our school office is open 8:00am - 4:00pm daily during the school term.

Informal chats before or after school: classrooms open at 8:40 am and teachers are available for ten minutes before the bell goes for a quick chat. Most days Donna and I are in the yard before or after school please feel free to chat with us at this time. Teachers are not available on Wednesday
