**Mobile Phone and device Policy** – this has been ratified by the Governing Council and is ready to go out to community. It is available on our website for you to read – please do. It outlines the roles of the school, educators, students and parents. No mobile phones can be used by school aged children once inside our school gates, and parents are requested to not be using them where possible.

**Online bullying issues** – we have been so lucky to date, but recently there are more and more issues occurring on weekends which are then having an effect on school. Please be aware of the apps your child is using. Ensure that they are of legal age. Discuss with them the dangers of allowing their phone to be used by others. Ensure your child is safe in this space. If you are concerned and there are issues arising, you can do the following:

- 1. Make a police report.
- 2. Report it to the e-safety commissioner https://www.esafety.gov.au/parents this is an excellent resource. Once you have accessed the page, there are a lot of resources available to you, as well as a link on the top right corner to make a report.

We thank you for your support in assisting your children to navigate this complex online world they live in.

**Uniform and missing jackets** – we have a lot of jackets going missing now that the weather has become cooler. A number of them are named. Can you please check your child's jumper at home and make sure they have not accidentally picked up someone else's. If so, please return it to school. If your child's jumper is not named, please ensure you do this asap, both up under the collar/tag, and on the back of the logo label.

**Jewellery** - is also starting to be worn, lots of bracelets, necklaces and dangly earrings. There should not be worn as they are an injury risk. Please check your child's uniform to ensure they are following the policy.

**Carparking** - Parents are encouraged to use Taylors Ave or Matison Road for parking, as well as along the oval side streets. The carpark outside the front office is only for staff from 7:30am - 4:15pm. OSHC parents are encouraged to park along the side of the driveway after 7:30am for drop offs. Please ensure this is happening as staff are struggling to access parking in the mornings.
