In the spirit of the current **COVID restrictions** the following arrangements are in place for at least the next week:

Access to school grounds

To minimise people entering the site, parents are asked to drop off/collect their children from the school gates. Non urgent service providers will not be able to enter the site. Parent-teacher meetings to be held on-line or by phone. Please contact staff via email or by phoning the front office.

Masks

Students in primary schools do not need to wear masks. All adults including parents need to wear masks including at OSHC. We strongly encourage parents to wear masks when dropping off/collecting their children at the school gates.

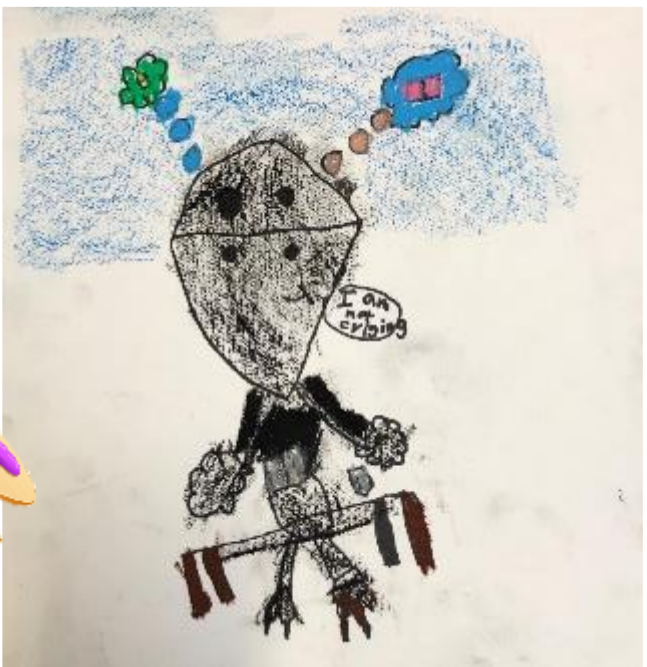
