Dear Families,

As a school we are on a journey to constantly build upon our thinking and learning skills. Sometimes the most obvious of these skills revolve around Maths and Literacy as those things are easily associated with school. Another vitally important part of the school experience revolves around social interaction and emotional literacy; students develop these skills over the course of their entire educational experience. At Coorara we are developing a Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) approach and with this there is a focus on teaching expected behaviour and our school values.

Previously our school had 5 core values. After seeking student voice, staff input and Governing Council feedback we have moved to 3 values: We are **Respectful**, **Responsible and Safe**. Along with these values we have developed a behaviour matrix which outlines how we expect these values to be displayed by our students utilising a 21st century mindset. This mindset includes but is not limited to: personal safety skills, ownership of learning and respect for others. Our behaviour matrix will be shared with families soon and is a great resource to promote conversation with your child at home.

One of the ways we will support students with behaviour learning is by sharing any behaviours of concern with home, detailing any issues and how they were resolved. Previously, a pink slip may have come home detailing behaviours and what the outcome was. With our new approach, if your child has displayed a behaviour of concern that does not align to our values, you will receive an email description of what has happened. As with all communication, if you need more information, the first contact point is your child's teacher.
