Not long, and we will be painting the school, well maybe just the children and staff multi-coloured! The **COLOUR EXPLOSION** is happening on Friday 26 September from 11:30 am. This will be so much fun. Our fantastic fundraising team have organised a BBQ lunch etc for children and parents on the day. Place your orders by Monday 22 September. During the lunch break there will be family activities to do as well, and a staff vs. seniors netball game.

All children can run in the **COLOUR EXPLOSION.** Glasses and headbands are for students who have raised over \$5.00. Children eligible for prizes must have raised over \$10 for the school. So far, we have raised \$4,500 to go towards the new senior playground. Let's see if we can break the \$10K mark.

Senior Playground revamp: You may have seen the barriers to the side of the senior playground. This is the start of the swings for the revamped playground, and is stage 1 of the 4 stages.

Enrolments and Leavers: Coorara Primary is open for enrolments for 2026 and 2027 school years. If you do not have your enrolments forms in, or you know of families that want to come to Coorara and have not yet enrolled, please collect an enrolment pack from the front office and submit enrolment form now.

I know that there are some families moving away from our area who will be attending new schools in 2026. If you are looking at moving your child from Coorara, please can you advise the front office as soon as possible. This assists us with our staffing and class placement.

Ready for Reception: Our reception transition program will commence in Term 4. This is for all children enrolled to start Reception in Term 1, 2026. Please be aware we are not zoned to a kindergarten or suburb and can accept most enrolments. Information about the program will be coming out next week.

Festival of Music: This fabulous event is coming up on 18 September. It will be a magical night as always, and to make it even more special, we get to be in the front row. This a such a credit to both Nikki and the students performing.

Basketball: Well done to our students who played in the SAPSASA basketball last week. Both the girls and boys teams played so well, with the boys team making it through to the finals in week 2 of Term 4. What a fantastic achievement.

HATS: As we head into Term 4, hats become a compulsory part of the school uniform. Please check your child has a hat for the first day of term. If not, please purchase one from the school at a cost of \$20, and make sure it is clearly named. Your child may still need a jumper in term 4 while the A/C works its magic inside the classrooms on hot days. Again, make sure these are named on the inside of the jumper, under the collar, or on the back of the Coorara logo is a good space. This way the name cannot be cut off!

Parking at the Kindergarten: Please make sure you are not parking in the row of parks allocated to Coorara Kindergarten staff. There is one space in the row missing its 'staff' sign, and we have school parents using this. Please keep the row of parks free. They need all of them in the mornings.

Planner for Term 4: There will be a Term Overview coming out shortly with the events for Term 4. It will include swimming information, Pupil Free Day, School Closure Day, Halloween Disco, Scholastic Book Fair and more.
