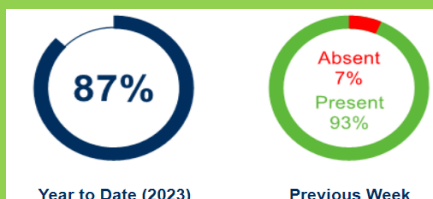

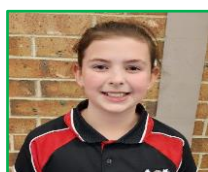
Week 2 - Term 4
