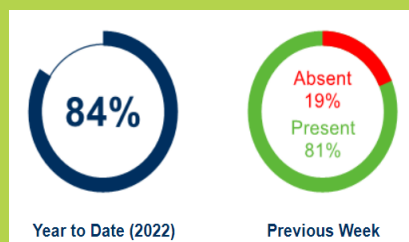

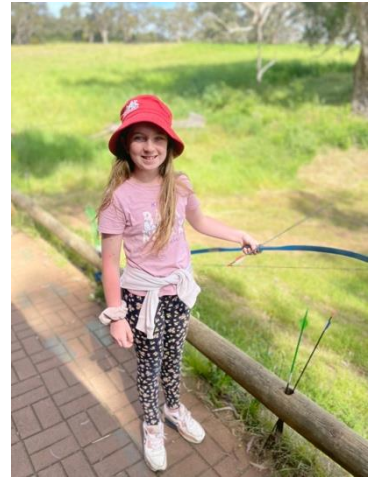


Wirraway Camp 2022
